

**PHILADELPHIA INTERNATIONAL FLOWER SHOW**  
**SPRINGTIME IN PARIS**  
**March 5-13, 2011**

Thinking about entering the Horticulture Classes in the upcoming Philadelphia International Flower Show? Why not try your hand at growing these new "named" bulb selections or challenge plants?

**General Bulb Classes** (open to all exhibitors)

- *Narcissus* 'Falconet' (Division 8, Tazetta). Pot: 8" or under.
- *Narcissus* 'Mount Hood' (Division 1, Trumpet). Pot: 8"-10".
- *Narcissus* 'Tête-à-Tête' (Miniature). Pot: 8" or under.
- *Tulipa* 'Monsella' (Division 2, Double Early). Pot: 8" or under.
- *Tulipa* 'Couleur Cardinal' (Division 3, Triumph). Pot: 10" or under.
- *Tulipa* 'Lady Jane' (species). Pot: 8" or under.
- *Allium neapolitanum* Cowanii Group. Pot: 8" or under.

**Novice Bulb Classes** (open to anyone who has never won a blue ribbon in the **Bulb Classes** at the Philadelphia International Flower Show prior to 2011)

- *Narcissus* 'Topolino' (Division 1, Trumpet). Pot: 8" or under
- *Tulipa* 'Calgary' (Division 3, Triumph). Pot: 8" or under.
- Any predominantly red *Hippeastrum* (Amaryllis); one single-nosed bulb. Pot: 6".

Note: All these bulbs must be grown and shown in pots of the size (inside diameter) specified.

**You may use bulb pans, azalea pots, or standard pots for all bulb classes.**

**Challenge Classes**

In a challenge class, all exhibitors start with the same plants and grow them for competition. **Only plants purchased from PHS are eligible for these classes.** A limited supply of the 2011 challenge plants will be available for purchase in the Shows Department at PHS, 100 N. 20th St., Philadelphia, PA 19103 (corner of 20th and Arch Sts.) during business hours beginning Wednesday, September 15; cost is \$7 each. Plants are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are limited to one each per exhibitor. No reservations can be accepted. To see if plants are still available, call PHS at 215-988-8800 and ask for the Shows Department.

Challenge plants will be announced in the 2011 *Exhibitor's Guide*.

**Horticulture Judging Days**

- Saturday, March 5
- Tuesday, March 8
- Friday, March 11
